


zbekistan is changing massively. Since 2017, the administration of President Shavkat Mirziyoyev has undertaken an ambitious set of reforms designed to replace the heavily regulated economic and social system that existed in the past.

A key goal of this massive transformation is the evolution of a heavily planned economic system into a modern market-based economy.

Until 2016 the government was strongly integrated into the economy and largely controlled economic production while playing a broad role in social and environmental issues.

The reforms underway in Uzbekistan are designed to change this and transform the nation into an economically and socially modern state.

TEXTILE VALUE CHAIN

A BOOMING VERTICALLY INTEGRATED TEXTILE INDUSTRY FROM FIBER TO END-PRODUCTS



- 1,520 million pieces of garment produced in 2020 and 310 million pairs of hosiery
- Growing production capacities in terry towels, bedlinen, jeans, knitted goods, etc.
- Modern CMT operations
- Production of 705 million m2 of woven fabrics and 160 k tons of knitted fabrics in 2020
- >70% of production exported
- Capability to manufacture a range of fabrics from sportswear, knits, bedlinen, etc.


TRADE AGREEMENTS

zbekistan has signed trade agreements with all CIS countries and benefit from the GSP+ regime with the EU since April 10th 2021.

As a beneficiary of GSP+, Uzbekistan will enjoy further economic benefits compared to the current Standard GSP arrangement.

The removal of tariffs on two thirds of the product lines covered by GSP will create opportunities for export growth and attract further investment in the country. The sustainable development commitments under GSP+ will further contribute to Uzbekistan's position as a reliable, forward-looking economic partner.
